MEN'S CLUB – 2024 OVERVIEW

The Breckenridge Men's Club is an organization that allows the golfer to play in a competitive and fun environment. The Club events are held on Wednesdays, from June 5th through September 11th.

• The Men's Club schedule is comprised of different events including individual, two man, and four man team events. Tee Times will be made in the same manner as last year. Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 8:30-11, 11-1 and 1-3. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign-up for the weekly event through Monday night.

For 2024, senior golfers 60+ may play from the Middle of Silver tees in all events. The Club Tees, which are green in color, will be the primary tees for handicap purposes.

- There is a \$5 weekly entry fee for each event
- Prize money is issued in the form of shop credit for pro shop merchandise
- Green fees are required for weekly play.

EVENT FORMATS

JUNE 5 - TWO BEST NET BALL OF FOUR

- Two best net balls of the four will be used for the team score
- 75% of handicap will be used.

JUNE 12 – INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD

• 100% of handicap will be used – points are scored on a net basis

DOUBLE EAGLE = 5	EAGLE = 4
BIRDIE = 3	PAR = 2
BOGEY = 1	DOUBLE BOGEY OR MORE = 0

JUNE 19 – TRIPLE PLAY

- Two person event
- Hole 1-6 will be best ball, hole 7-12 will be modified scotch, and hole 13-18 will be scramble
- 25% of combined team handicap will be used

JUNE 26 - TWO PERSON BEST NET BALL

- 2 Person event- One Best Net Ball will count as team score for hole.
- Seniors will play from silver tees, all others will play from green tees.
- 75% of handicap will be used.

JULY 3 – ONE NET + ONE GROSS BEST BALL OF FOURSOME

- One player's ball cannot be used for both net and gross scores
- Two different scores must be used
- 100% of handicap will be used

JULY 10 - STEP ASIDE

- Four person event
- All four players tee off and play off the best ball
- The person's ball that is chosen must "step aside" and is not allowed to hit the next shot
- Continue until the ball is on the green, all four players will putt.
- Handicap: 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D.

JULY 17 – LOW GROSS/LOW NET

- 100% of handicap will be used.
- Scoring will be on a gross and a net basis.

JULY 24 - TWO MAN TEAM STABLEFORD

- One best net point per hole will be used for the team score
- 75% of handicap will be used.

DOUBLE EAGLE = 5	EAGLE = 4
BIRDIE = 3	PAR = 2
BOGEY = 1	DOUBLE BOGEY OR MORE = 0

JULY 31 – THREE, TWO, ONE

- A four person team will count three net best balls on the par threes, two net best balls on the par fours and one best net ball on the par fives.
- 100% of handicap will be used

AUG 7 – CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP- DAY 1

To be eligible you must have played in at least two regular season events or be a member in 2023.

36-hole stroke play (weather permitted)

- Handicaps for this event will be based on Aug 6th USGA revision.
- Applied Handicap will be used for both weeks
- Flights: Championship: 0.0 8.0 Index- any index golfer may play in this flight

Open: 8.1 – 36.0 index Senior: Ages 60 and over

- Gross and Net division for championship, open, and senior flights
- All USGA rules govern play including local rules

AUG 14 – CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP- DAY 2

- Must have played in round 1 to be eligible for day 2
- Handicaps for this event will be based on Aug 6th USGA revision.

AUG 21 – TWO MAN SHAMBLE

Two person teams required

- Players will tee off and play from the drive of choice
- Players then play their own ball for the remainder of the hole
- One best net ball will be scored
- 50% of handicap will be used.

AUG 28 – TEXAS SCRAMBLE

- Four person teams
- All players tee off and play off the best ball for the entirety of the hole
- A minimum of four dives must be used per player.
- Handicap: 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D.

SEPT 4 – INDIVIDUAL LOW NET

- 100% of handicap
- This is the last event of the year for Player of the Year standings

SEPT 11 – TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS @ BGC

• Weekly winners are eligible to compete in a low gross, low net format. This year the event will be held at Breckenridge Golf Club.



SEASON LONG MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT

Entry Deadline: The first 32 paid entries.

Entry Fee: \$20

Prizes: Gift certificates to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places.

(Based on 32 players - \$250, \$175, \$110 & \$110)

Format: Match Play at 100% home course handicap, single elimination. Each match must

be completed within the prescribed time frame.

Any matches not completed will be decided by a coin flip!!!

The final match must be completed no later than September 11th.

Rules: USGA match play rules will be in effect. The following local rules will apply:

• All matches must be played from the green tees.

- Players may play a nine-hole match if both players agree.
- Players may agree to match scorecards if not playing together; however there must be at least two other players to attest the score (one must be part of Men's League).
- Matches must use the most current handicap available for each player.



PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- During most events this season, prize money in the form of pro shop credit, will be awarded according to your finish position during each week's event. Money will accumulate throughout the season with the player of the year award going to the player who accumulates the most money during the season. The money total should represent the player who played consistently well and who played in the majority of the events during the season. Prize money is always in the form of pro shop merchandise credit.
- A reminder that all pro shop credit must be used in the current season. Shop credit will no longer carry over year to year.



RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- Events will be held on Wednesdays, and you must tee off during the block of times reserved for men's club (a maximum of 160 spots per week)
 - Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 8:30-11, 11-11, and 1-3. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign-up for the weekly event through **Monday** night, although you are not guaranteed a time.
 - If you must cancel, please give staff a **MINIMUM of 48 hours' notice**. Failure to give proper notice will result in disqualification from future events.
 - Tee times must be observed. Please show up a **MINUMUM of 15 minutes** before your scheduled time. Failure to show up on time will result in disqualification from league.
- Slow play will not be tolerated. You must keep pace with the group in front of you. Be ready to play with club in hand when it is your turn. Rounds should be completed in no more than 4½ hours. If you are not keeping up with the group in front of you your group is behind. Failure to keep pace will result in 2 warnings followed by disqualification from league.
- Handicaps must be established to compete in league. You must post every score whether you play at
 home or away. Those without GHIN will need to post a minimum of five current scores (last 12
 months) before they are eligible for league play. Violations will result in disqualification from league
 at the discretion of the Golf & Nordic Manager, Golf & Nordic Coordinator, and Head Professional.
- Replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake the sand to a smooth surface. Leave the course in better condition than you found it.
- All USGA rules govern play, except where modified by local rules. A "Gentleman's provisional" is allowed for balls hit into areas marked as water hazards.
- For all league play at the Breckenridge Golf Club, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only, NO SLOPE ADJUSTMENTS ALLOWED.

LIGHTNING PROCEDURES

• USGA rule 6-8a authorizes a player to discontinue play if he or she considers that there is danger from lightning. The safety of the players is paramount, especially as there is a natural fear of lightning. Please take necessary precautions such as finding one of the weather shelters on the golf course. The maintenance building, starter shed, and clubhouse should also be utilized.

HANDICAP PROCEDURES AND SCORE POSTING

- World Handicap System- With the daily update occurring with the new handicap system,
 Breckenridge Golf Club will use indexes from the Sunday prior to each event.
- Each player is responsible for posting his or her own score in the handicap computer or by using the GHIN mobile app. Golf shop staff WILL NOT post players scores.
- Always adjust your scores with new maximum score rule;
 - **Maximum Score** The maximum hole score for each player will be limited to a Net Double Bogey.
 - \circ Par + 2 + any handicap strokes you receive = Max Score
 - o Example: Joe- Course Handicap of 20

Hardest Hole-#1 Handicap Hole Par 4
Double Bogey + 2
Strokes on Hole + 2

Maximum Score 8 = Max Score for Hole

- When posting scores to GHIN we recommend posting either "Hole-by-Hole" or "Hole-by-Hole with Stats". This will automatically adjust to your maximum score.
- Handicaps will update daily for 2024.
- Ask the pro shop staff for assistance with any questions!
