WOMEN'S CLUB – 2024 OVERVIEW

The Breckenridge Women's Club is an organization that allows golfers to play in a competitive and fun environment. The Club events are held on Tuesdays, from June 4th through September 10th.

- The Women's Club schedule is comprised of different events including individual, two person, and four person team events. The goal each year is to create a competitive, equitable, and enjoyable club. Each year we add/delete events to keep the schedule fresh. Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 8:30-10, or 10-11. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign up for the weekly event through Sunday night, although you are not guaranteed a spot.
- Ladies Club members are able to choose their teams and pairings to allow players to play with friends. If you are a member that does not have a team or a group to play with, our staff will help you find a good pairing. We hope all members will be open to playing with new players throughout the year. Staff will set up pairings for Club Championship and certain events TBD.

- There is a \$5 weekly entry fee for each event.
- Prize money is issued in the form of shop credit for pro shop merchandise.
- Green fees are required for weekly play.

2024 EVENT FORMATS

JUNE 4 – LOW GROSS/LOW NET

- Full handicap for the net division
- Players may only place in one division
- 100% of handicap will be used.

JUNE 11 - STEP ASIDE

- Four-person event
- All four players tee off and play off the best ball.
- The person's ball that is chosen must "step aside" and is not allowed to hit the next shot.
- Continue until the ball is on the green, all four players will putt.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D

JUNE 18 – CHA, CHA, CHA

- Four-person event
- The staff will assign teams based on handicaps.
- Scoring will be on a net basis for 18-holes. 1 best ball will count on the 1st hole, 2 on the 2nd, and 3 on the 3rd. 1 score on the 4th, 2 on the 5th, and so on
- 100% of handicap will be used.

JUNE 25 – INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD

• 100% of handicap will be used – points are scored on a net basis.

Double Eagle = 5	Eagle = 4
Birdie = 3	Par = 2
Bogey = 1	Double bogey or more = 0

JULY 2 – TWO NET BEST BALLS OF THE FOURSOME

- Scoring will be on a net basis.
- Record the two net best balls of the foursome.
- 75% of handicap will be used.

JULY 9 – ODDS & EVENS

- Four-person event
- 1 best net ball will be counted on the odd numbered holes and 2 best net balls will be counted on the even numbered holes.
- 75% of handicap will be used.

JULY 16 – BETTER BALL OF PARTNERS

- Two player teams. Handicaps are applied on the appropriate holes. The team
 will have a net better ball on each hole, which will be recorded as a team
 score.
- 75% of handicap will be used.

JULY 23 – TWO PERSON STABLEFORD

- One best net point per hole will be used for the team score.
- 100% of handicap will be used.

Double Eagle = 5	Eagle = 4
Birdie = 3	Par = 2
Bogey = 1	Double bogey or more = 0

JULY 30 - THREE, TWO, ONE

- The staff will assign teams based on handicaps.
- A four-person team will count three net best balls on the par threes, two net best balls on the par fours and one net best ball on the par fives.

AUG 6 – CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- To be eligible you must have played in at least two regular season events or been a member in 2022.
- This year's Club Championship is an 18-hole event.
- Gross and Net Division
- Trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place finishers.

AUG 13 – TWO PERSON SHAMBLE

- 2-person team required
- Both players will tee off and play from the drive of choice
- Players then play their own ball for the remainder of the hole.
- One best net ball will be scored.
- 50% of handicap will be used.

AUG 20 – BETTER BALL OF BLIND PARTNER

- Staff will assign partners after everyone has teed off.
- One best net ball will count for the team score.
- 100% of handicap will be used.

AUG 27 – TEXAS SCRAMBLE

- Four person teams
- All players tee off and play off the best ball for the entirety of the hole.
- A minimum of four drives must be used per player.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D

SEPT 3 – LOW NET

- Scoring will be on a net basis.
- 100% of handicap will be used.

SEPT 10 - TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS OR TBD

• Weekly winners are eligible to compete in a low gross, low net format. This year the event will be held at Breckenridge Golf Club

SEASON LONG DOUBLES MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT

In 2024 Breckenridge Golf Club is proud to continue a new twist on an old format. This season instead of hosting an individual match play tournament for our Women's League we will be introducing a doubles Match Play format. This tournament will consist of between 8-16 teams of two. This will give you the opportunity to experience a Match Play format, but in a more relaxed and friendly setting. Players can choose their teammate, or golf shop staff can help assist you in finding a partner. Matches will still need to be set up/played on your own time. Match Play matches will not be played during normal Women's League days. We hope to get more players involved, while keeping it fun, friendly, and stress free.

Entry Deadline: JUNE 11TH

Entry Fee: \$30 per team

Prizes: Shop Credit to 1st and 2nd

(Based on 16 teams - \$150/person and \$100/person)

Format: Match Play at 100% home course handicap, single elimination. Each match must

be completed within the prescribed time frame.

2 person teams counting one best net ball for team score.

Any matches that are not completed will be decided by a coin flip!!!

The final match must be completed no later than September 10th.

Rules: USGA match play rules will be in effect. The following local rules will apply:

- All matches must be played from the red tees.
- Players may play a nine-hole match if both parties agree.
- Matches must use the most current handicap available for each player.
- Handicaps will be based off low players handicap.



PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- During most events this season, prize money in the form of pro shop credit will be awarded according to your finish position during each week's event. Money will accumulate throughout the season with the player of the year award going to the player who accumulates the most money during the season. The money total should represent the player who played consistently well and who played in the majority of the events during the season. Prize money is always in the form of pro shop merchandise credit.
- A reminder that all pro shop credit must be used in the current season. Shop credit will no longer carry over year to year.



RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- Events will be held on Tuesdays, and you must tee off during the block of times reserved for women's club (a maximum of 52 spots per week)
 - Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 8:30-10, and 10-11. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign-up for the weekly event through **Sunday** night, although you are not guaranteed a time.
 - If you must cancel, please give staff a **minimum of 48 hours' notice**. Failure to give proper notice will result in disqualification from future events.
 - Tee times must be observed. Please show up a **MINUMUM** of 15 minutes before your scheduled time. Failure to show up on time will result in disqualification from league.
- Slow play will not be tolerated. You must keep pace with the group in front of you. Be ready to play with club in hand when it is your turn. Rounds should be completed in no more than 4½ hours. If you are not keeping up with the group in front of you your group is behind. Failure to keep pace will result in 2 warnings followed by disqualification from league.
- Handicaps must be established to compete in league. You must post every score whether you play at home or away. Those without GHIN will need to post a minimum of five current scores (last 12 months) before they are eligible for league play. Violations will result in disqualification from league at the discretion of the Golf & Nordic Manager, Golf & Nordic Coordinator, and Head Professional.
- Replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake the sand to a smooth surface. Leave the course in better condition than you found it.
- All USGA rules govern play, except where modified by local rules. A "Ladies provisional" is allowed for balls hit into areas marked as water hazards.
- For all league play at the Breckenridge Golf Club, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only, NO SLOPE ADJUSTMENTS ALLOWED.

LIGHTNING PROCEDURES

• USGA rule 6-8a authorizes a player to discontinue play if he or she considers that there is danger from lightning. The safety of the players is paramount, especially as there is a natural fear of lightning. Please take necessary precautions such as finding one of the weather shelters on the golf course. The maintenance building, starter shed, and clubhouse should also be utilized.

HANDICAP PROCEDURES AND SCORE POSTING

- World Handicap System- With the daily update occurring with the new handicap system, Breckenridge Golf Club will use indexes from the Sunday prior to each event.
- Each player is responsible for posting his or her own score in the handicap computer or by using the GHIN mobile app. Golf shop staff WILL NOT post players scores.
- Always adjust your scores with new maximum score rule.
 - **Maximum Score** The maximum hole score for each player will be limited to a Net Double Bogey.
 - \circ Par + 2 + any handicap strokes you receive = Max Score
 - o Example: Joe- Course Handicap of 20

Hardest Hole-#1 Handicap Hole Par 4
Double Bogey + 2
Strokes on Hole + 2

Maximum Score 8 = Max Score for Hole

- When posting scores to GHIN we recommend posting either "Hole-by-Hole" or "Hole-by-Hole with Stats". This will automatically adjust to your maximum score.
- Handicaps will update daily for 2024.
- Ask the pro shop staff for assistance with any questions!
